#### **Program Overview**

- 10-week summer research opportunity for students
- Program sponsor/funder
  - MPower, formal partnership between University of Maryland College Park & University of Maryland Baltimore
- Willing to fund multiple students for interprofessional experience

- How are health professions, social work & law students being educated about health literacy?
- How is this education being evaluated?
- What are the most effective ways to promote an interprofessional approach to health literacy education & skill development?
- What types of policies would promote an interprofessional, health literate workforce?



#### **Interprofessional Competencies**

- Coleman, Hudson & Pederson 2017 report on prioritized health literacy & clear communication practices
  - 7-8 practices shared across disciplines
- Provided list to assess literature & curricula


### Interprofessional Education (IPE)

- Health literacy is multi-faceted & team-based approach is warranted
- UMB has a Center for Interprofessional Education, launched in 2013
  - Provides students from two or more disciplines opportunity to collaborate & improve health outcomes

#### **IPE & Health Literacy**

- Example of team-based approach to health literacy
  - Interprofessional Team Care Clinics in Montgomery County, Maryland
    - Patients: Low-income, uninsured, primarily Latino patients with uncontrolled diabetes and a psychosocial condition
    - Students: Pharmacy, Nursing (DNP/FNP), Social Work, Dietetics
  - Tools to Address Health Literacy
    - Chronic disease, nutrition & medication education
    - Manna Food Center
    - Medbank & Pharmadex
    - Financial Counselor onsite





#### **IPE Application: President's Clinic**

- President's Interprofessional Clinic
  - UMB students recruited from 6 schools
    - Attend 3 didactic sessions
    - Attend Pediatric Gastroenterology Clinic
- Goal
  - Broaden students' knowledge, attitudes & beliefs regarding interprofessional team-based care

#### President's Clinic & Health Literacy

- Social determinants of health
  - Introduction & overview of social determinants of health
- Health literacy as a social determinant
  - Didactic session
  - Case study
  - Clinic

#### Oral Health & Interprofessionalism

- Dentistry & medicine have been silos since first dental school opened
- Serious consequences hurt most vulnerable & contribute to disparities
- Some signs of interprofessionalism

#### **Oral Health & Health Literacy**

- Individuals with low levels of oral health literacy
  - Lower levels of knowledge of disease
  - Higher rates of disease
  - Fewer preventive dental visits
  - Increased no show rates
  - Lower level of oral health quality of life
  - Unaware of relationship of diabetes/gum disease



# Health Sciences & Human Services Library Perspectives

- Library's interests
  - Health literacy workshops
  - Strategic plan
- Contribution to literature search
  - Determined type of review
  - Search techniques & terms
  - Discipline specific databases
  - Citation manager
  - Challenges: different vocabularies & access



#### **Medical Student Perspective**

- Health literacy in medical education
  - Global view: licensing standards
  - Summary of literature review
- Areas for growth
  - Standardization of HL education
  - Real-world application to patient care
  - Interprofessional collaboration

#### **Nursing Student Perspective**

- Health literacy in nursing education
  - Brief summary of the literature
  - Represented in patient education & communication
- Areas for growth
  - Integration
  - Consistency, language
  - Evaluation

## Medical/Nursing Student Collaborations

- Associate's degree in nursing teaching partnership
- Health literacy themed clinical replacement
  - Prep work
  - Didactic/active learning module
  - Medicine/nursing collaborative perspective
